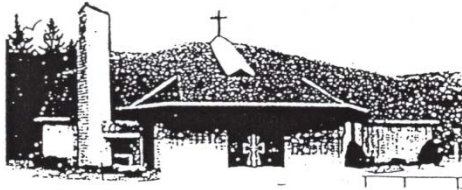

This weekend we celebrate the accomplishments of our High School Graduates with a Mass in their honor at 10:00 am on Sunday. The Hands and Hearts of Mary will host an Ice Cream Social for the graduates and their families immediately following the Mass.

We also celebrate Father's Day. Father's Day dates back to 1909 in Spokane Washington. Sonora Smart Dodd was listening to a Mother's Day sermon, at her Church. The lecture inspired her to have a special day dedicated to her father, who had single-handedly brought up her and her siblings after their mother died. To pay tribute to her great dad, Sonora held the first Father's Day celebration on 19th of June 1910 -- the birthday of her father. It was not until 1972, however, that Father's Day was established as a permanent day to recognize and honor fathers. Today, we recognize all fathers -- those still with us, and those who have gone before us -- for their sacrifices, courage, selflessness, guidance and love.
